

RE: Notification of compliance with the Administrative Order issued to the City of Sweet Home, OR4100851

The City of Sweet Home is a public water system that is subject to the requirements of Oregon Revised Statutes, Chapter 448, and Oregon Administrative Rules 333-061-0005 to 333-061-0295.

The Oregon Department of Human Services, Public Health Division, Office of Environmental Public Health, Drinking Water Program (Agency) issued a Notice of Violation and Administrative Order on October 13, 1998 to the City of Sweet Home for specific violations of the Oregon Drinking Water Quality Act and rules. The agency subsequently issued two additional administrative orders and multiple extensions.

The Agency is issuing this letter as notification that the City of Sweet Home has achieved full compliance with the original and subsequent administrative orders and extensions. This notification does not relieve the City of Sweet Home of any other regulatory requirements specified in the Oregon Drinking Water Quality Act; ORS 448.115 to 448.285 and administrative rules OAR 333-061-0005 to 333-061-0295.
